**James** - executed (Acts 12)

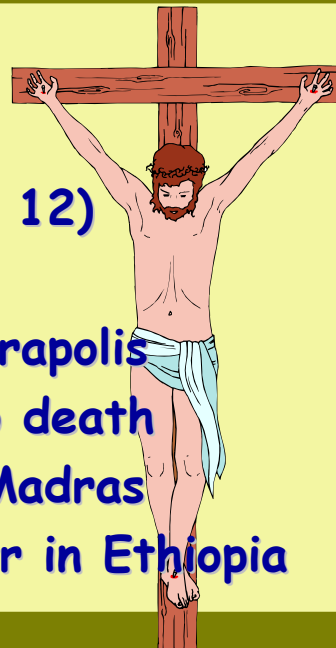
**John** - exiled to Patmos
