The Terrible Image

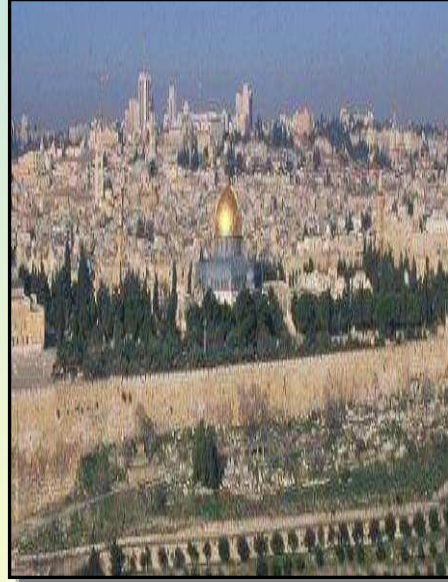


Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

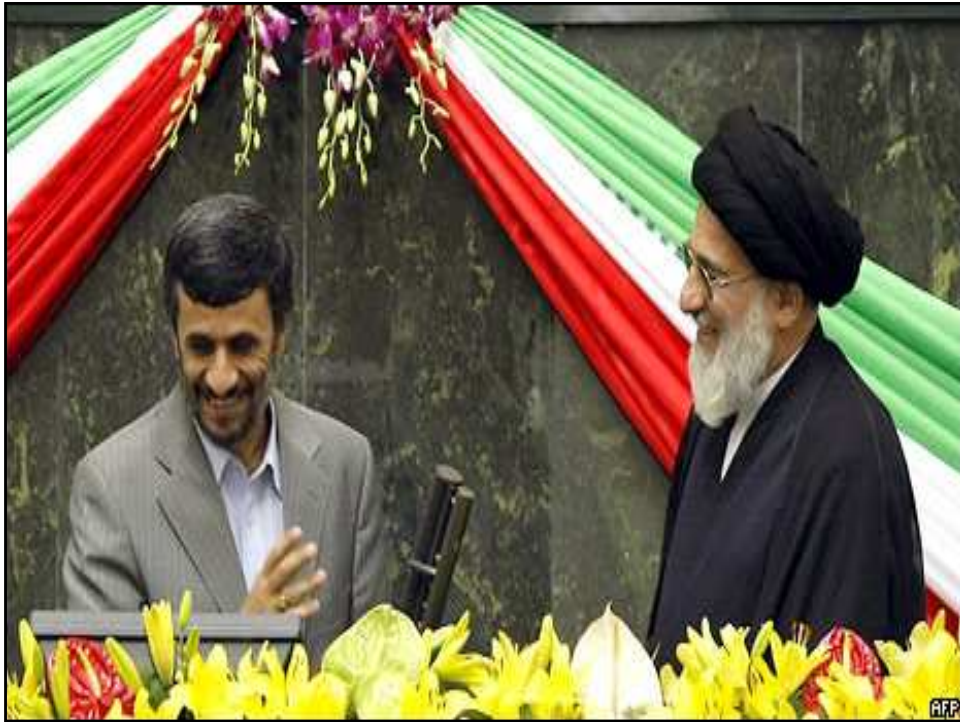

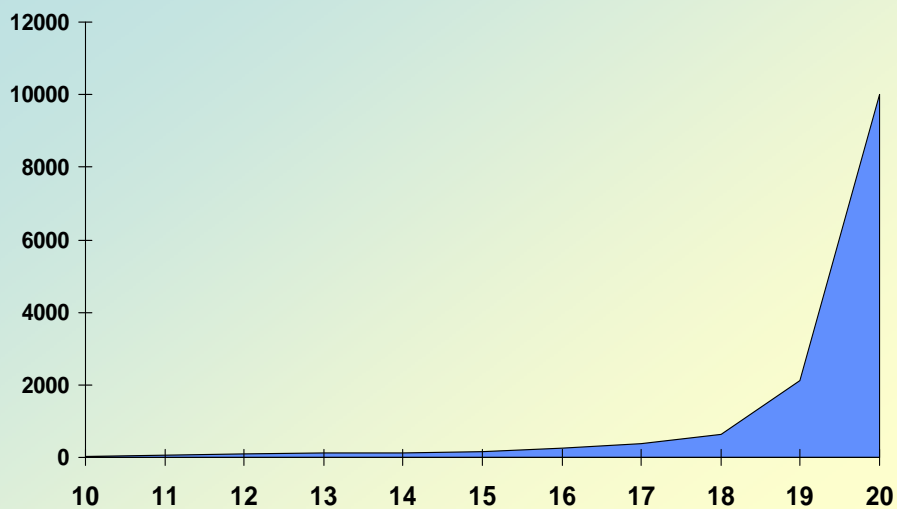
Famines, disease, earthquakes

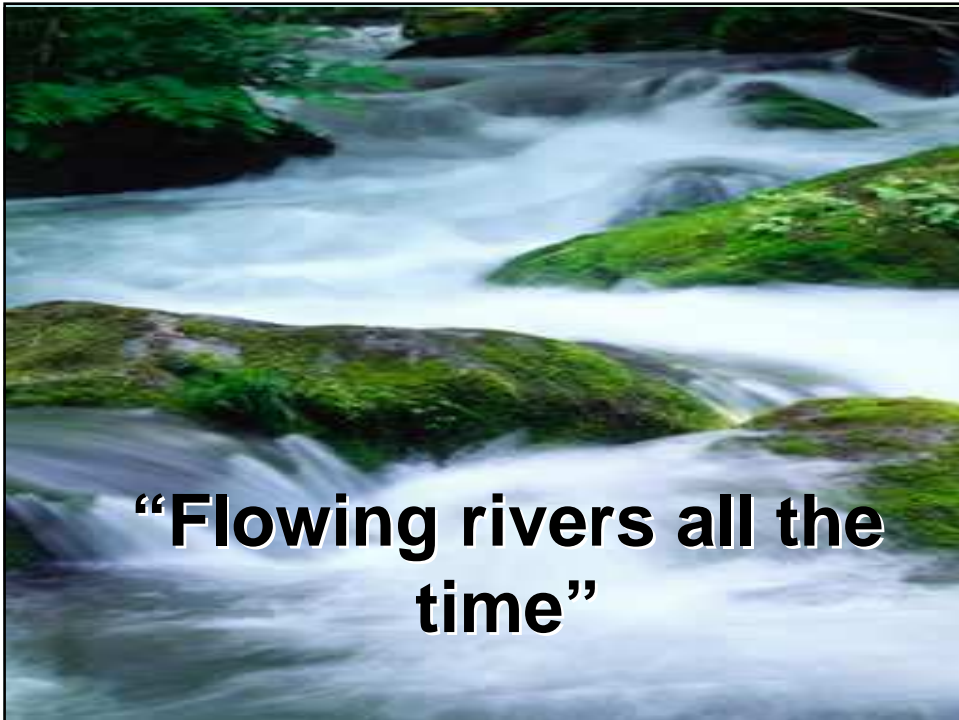



Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

*“except a man be born again into a new life in Jesus **through the waters of baptism**, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.”*
