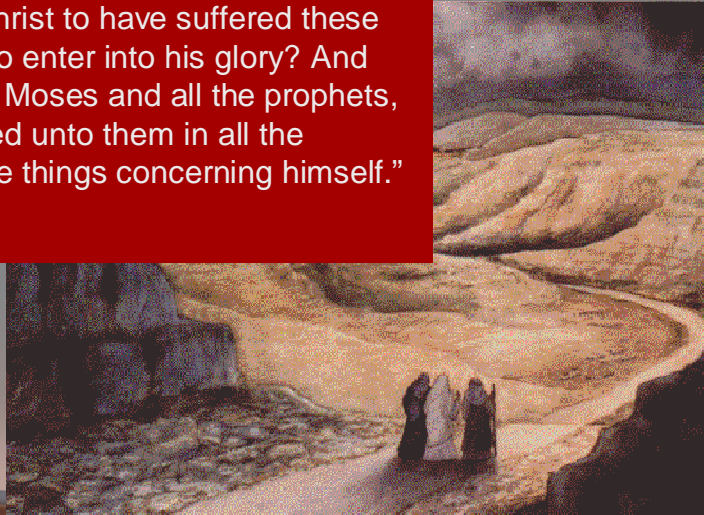

Isaiah 53

15

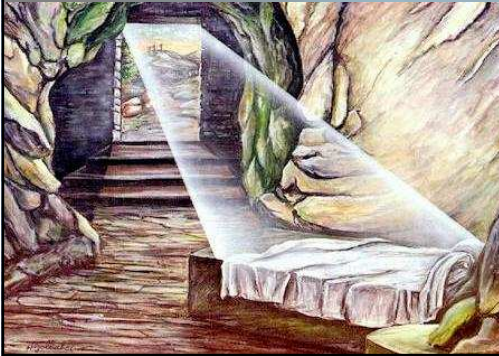
